Transportation Voucher Program

Who is eligible for the indiGO Transportation Voucher Program?

- People with disabilities or people aged 65+ who live in indiGo's eight-county region, in areas not served by public transportation and,
- do not have adequate access to transportation and,
- have income at or below 200% of Federal Poverty Level. (\$27,180 for an individual in 2022)

How Does the Voucher Program Work?

- You'll receive vouchers you can use like checks to reimburse drivers for travel you need.
- You recruit your own drivers
- Additional transportation options may be available to meet individual needs.
- You'll develop your own individualized transportation plan.
- Your Individualized Transportation Plan includes your monthly funding allocation for voucher program travel.
- Since the program could end depending on funding, you'll work with the Transportation Coordinator to ensure you are able to continue getting where you need to go
- Public transit rides are not eligible for reimbursement
