

How Does the Voucher Program Work?

You'll receive vouchers you can use like checks to reimburse drivers for travel you need.

You recruit your own drivers.

Additional transportation options may be available to meet individual needs.

You'll develop your own individualized transportation plan.

Your Individualized Transportation Plan includes your monthly funding allocation for voucher program travel.

Since the program could end depending on funding, you'll work with the Transportation Coordinator to ensure you are able to continue getting where you need to go

Rides on public transportation are not eligible for reimbursement

- Have income at or below 200% of Federal Poverty Level.
